Supplementary House Rules for guests with dogs

During the last 18 seasons we have had many guests who have been able to enjoy having their dogs with them. Given our location we appreciate it is hard to think of leaving them in kennels miles away. In most cases owners have ensured the dogs are looked after, respect the property and do not cause any damage to the furnishings and fittings.

Please observe our basic dog rules in addition to the Terms and Conditions and House Rules.

We allow one dog per cottage by prior arrangement and charge an extra £25 per stay.

1. Your dog should be kept under control at all times. Lambing is a definite time to adhere to this. It should not enter fields except on a lead and should not chase wildlife including our ducks and geese.
2. Please ensure your dog is clean and dry before going into the cottages. We have pale floors and carpets so would appreciate clean paws and feet! DRYING TOWELS ARE A MUST.
3. Your dog must sleep in its own bed in the hallway.
4. The cottages are thoroughly cleaned after each guest, however if we have to bring in a contract cleaner due to excessive dog dirt then this charge will be passed on to the dog owner. Please advise us in plenty of time if any damage has been caused in order that we can make good before the next guests arrive.
5. We ask that you do not allow your dog to go onto the beds or the sofas at any time.
6. Your dog should not be left alone in the cottage (unless you have a dog cage.)
7. Please do not bring female dogs if in season.
8. There are some fabulous walks around the property so please make sure, if possible, that fouling takes place out of the garden area and beyond the drive.

We appreciate your co-operation and consideration to the above.
